PULSE NITE-CLUB, LETTERKENNY:

The floor is surrounded by individual glass panels and has LED colour changers that impressively light up inside each pane. The Club boasts the first 3-D lighting effect feature in Ireland which is over the dance floor and is a must-see. Lighting beams shoot down through rods and pulsate to the music.
